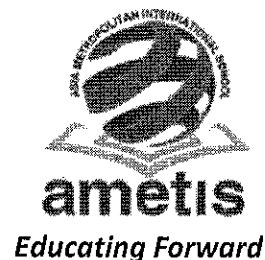

The learners recorded 49.2% 'A\*' & 'A', and 44% 'B' & 'C'. This brings the total credits to 93.2%. The GPA for the individual subjects also shows a positive trend with an average GPA of a 'B' and above.
